- C. CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Robert H. Bunch called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Consideration/Approval of Agenda Items

- D. Consideration and possible action to approve the minutes for the September 13, 2021, Regular Called Meeting. – Motion made by Councilmember Jimmy Norwood and seconded by Councilmember Dale Vickers. All in favor.
- E. Consideration and/or possible action to approve Resolution R11-2021;A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Nash, Texas, designating an official newspaper for the City of Nash for Fiscal Year 2022 - Motion was made by Councilmember Danica Porter to approve Resolution R11-2021, designating the Texarkana Gazette as the official newspaper for the City of Nash’s fiscal year 2022 and seconded by Councilmember Jimmy Norwood. All in favor
- F. Consideration and/or possible action by Council to cast votes for the election of Board of Directors of the Bowie Central Appraisal District for the 2022-2023 term – Motion was made by Councilmember Dale Vickers to split the votes evenly between Amy Bowers, Paul Miller and Robert Sheppard giving them each twenty-six votes and seconded by Councilmember Troy James. Open Forum/Citizens Comments:

1. Ray Smith - 258 N Pecan – Mr. Smith told the Council that he now lives on a half street because the roadbed is supposed to be 26-27 foot wide and is now twenty feet of asphalt. Mr. Smith wants to know if someone “skimmed a little money on this project?” Mr. Smith said, “That he knows Nash is not that broke and we could

afford the other two feet on the road. There are bicycles being ridden on this road and it does not look good and if they had put in the twenty-four feet then I wouldn't have said anything. I didn't know if that was some of them Texarkana College Engineers that dreamed that up. Did I say college? I meant junior college because that is all that is because you can look at some of their advertisements on tv and they don't even meet OSHA regulations. You can believe that you better know what you are looking at. That's what I think about every time they want to raise my taxes and the City of Nash raised my taxes too and I am supposed to be grandfathered in but guess what it isn't. It went up and that's all I have to say." Mayor Bunch told Ray that we would look into the Engineers specs and maps and make sure that the road was installed with the spec that they were given. Mr. Smith said, "Excuse me I have one more thing, what about them apartments next door to me. Are they going to be two story?" Mayor Bunch confirmed that they would be two-story. Mr. Smith said, "You know that we have done been in this argument before, so we got to go get the lawyers in there like Texarkana did huh?" Mayor Bunch told him that was what was approved by the proper City department.
